

Program Details

Overview: This program is designed to recognize the outstanding achievements of certified staff who are integrating technology with our curriculum to make a difference in the lives of Unit 10 students! Each year, up to three certified staff members will be recognized as “e-Educators of the Year” by the Collinsville Community Unit School District.

Judges: A panel of judges will review the nomination packets and select the award recipients.

Due Date: Nominations will be due to the Director of Technology on June 1, 2017.

Presentation of Awards: Announcement of the award recipients will take place at the 2017-2018 First Day Teachers’ Institute.

Nomination Details:

- 1) A nomination may be made by any person employed by Collinsville Community Unit School District. All certified employees of Unit 10 are eligible for nomination.
- 2) A nomination packet (details on next page) must be completed for each nominee.
- 3) The nominee’s name should be placed in the upper right corner of all nomination pages.
- 4) The completed nomination packet should be returned to the Director of Technology by June 1, 2017.

Section 2 – Nominator Recommendation

Please provide a detailed narrative that describes why you believe the certified staff member deserves district-wide recognition as an e-Educator. Maximum length of two double-spaced pages. You may wish to collaborate with the nominee when composing the narrative.

Suggested topics:

- How does the nominee integrate technology with the district's curriculum into their classroom?
- How is the nominee using technology to enrich the learning environment?
- What evidence supports the impact of technology in the nominee's learning environment?
- How does the nominee inspire students?
- How does the nominee support the technology vision?
