

PHYSICAL AND IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

As a part of registration and entry into Collinsville Unit School District 10, your child(ren) will be required to provide a health examination and proof of specific immunizations against preventable communicable diseases per Illinois Department of Public Health regulations. The following guidelines will help you meet these requirements.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

1. Physicals are required:
 - *prior to entering pre-kindergarten, early childhood, kindergarten or first, sixth and ninth grades
 - *when transferring from out-of-state or out-of-country (must be within one year and recorded on the Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination form)
 - *at age 5, 10 or 15 if attending school programs where grade levels are not assigned.
2. Physical exams are to be completed by a licensed MD, DO, PA, or NP
3. Physical exams are to be completed on the Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination form. Only this form will be accepted.
4. These physical exams are accepted if done up to one year prior to entry of the appropriate grade level.
5. All areas of Certificate of Child Health Examination form must be completed:
 - *required immunizations with healthcare provider signature:

DPT	Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus
Tdap booster	Tetanus, Diphtheria, acellular Pertussis
OPV or IPV	Polio
MMR	Measles, Mumps, Rubella
Hib	Haemophilus influenza type B
Hep B	Hepatitis B
Varicella	Chickenpox
DT Booster	Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap meets requirement)
PCV	Pneumococcal
MCV4	Meningococcal
 - *alternative proof of immunity if applicable
 - *other recommended immunizations include Flu vaccine, Hepatitis A, Meningococcal Conjugate (MCV4)
 - *health history with parent signature
 - *physical assessment data (height, weight, BP)
 - *Diabetes screening (BMI, risk assessment)
 - *Lead risk assessment: Lead Questionnaire or blood test required for all students age 6 mo. to 6 yrs.
 - *TB skin test is recommended only for children in high-risk groups
 - *Physician examination evaluation, signature, and date
6. If your child is participating in **sports** (7-12 grades), he/she will need an annual sports physical (Note – the ninth grade entry physical may be used for the sports physical during the freshman year only.) Please use the *IHSA physical form*. The form can be printed by going to www.kahoks.org. You may also pick up the form at the CHS Athletic office or the registration office at 123 W. Clay St., Collinsville, IL.

DENTAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Dental exams are required:
 - *by May 15 of the kindergarten, second, and sixth grades
 - *will accept an exam completed within 18 months prior to May 15 of required grade level
2. Dental exams are to be completed on the Illinois Department of Public Health Proof of School Dental Examination form. Form must be signed and dated by Dentist.
3. A Dental Waiver form may be available upon request.

EYE EXAMS

Eye Exams are required for all Kindergarten students and students who have not previously attended an Illinois school. Must be done by Eye doctor and charted on Illinois state form.

Illinois State Board of Education requires that our students meet the health requirements by the first day of school for those grades needing new exams. We are obligated to exclude students from school who are still lacking the required health exam and immunizations if we have not received these by the district exclusion date. If your child is excluded for lack of a health exam or immunizations, truancy may become an issue.

Call the school nurse at your child's school for questions, concerns, or the required exam forms.
