

## **Classes of Organizations**

- Class I**
1. School sponsored student organizations.
  2. Official staff organizations among employees of the District.
  3. Community organizations directly affiliated with the schools when no admission is charged, such as PTA, athletic booster clubs, YMCA latchkey, and music parent organizations.
- Class II**
1. All Class I groups, if the activity is for fund raising.
  2. Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, YMCA, and similar organizations.
- Class III**
1. Civic, government, parochial, and not-for-profit schools, religious recreational, cultural, and charitable organizations that have their headquarters and principal membership within the boundaries of the District and the activity is not for fund raising. NOTE: All admissions received by Class III groups while using school facilities must be dedicated to educational, charitable, cultural, or religious limits of the District.
  2. Colleges and universities.\*
- Class IV**
1. All Class III organizations involved in a fund-raising activity.
- Class V**
1. Groups within the District for profit where such profit is to be used for the advancement of the group
  2. Groups outside the District for non-profit, religious, charitable, philanthropic, civic, or other non-commercial, non personal uses.
- Class VI**
1. Groups outside the District for profit.
  2. Individual citizens for personal profit.

\*Separate agreements may be made with colleges and universities conducting credit and non-credit classes which are open to the citizens of Unit #10.
